



Non-accounting majors are required to earn a minimum 2.25 GPA in all business and economics courses, as well as a 2.25 GPA in all business and economics courses completed at UWM, to graduate. Final Honors Final honors are given to students who earn the following GPAs on a minimum of 60 graded UWM credits: Cum Laude - 3.500 or above; Magna Cum Laude - 3.650 or above; Summa Cum Laude - 3.800 or above. General Business majors may not select a second major within the Lubar School of Business but may select any number of certificates. Certificate Option Students have the option to complete one or more certificates in conjunction with BBA majors. The Information Technology Management (ITM) degree provides undergraduate students with the knowledge needed to develop creative and effective business solutions, based on a thorough comprehension of business problems and opportunities. What is a Bachelor in Information Technology Management? Some graduates work in network administration, database development or information security. Online national job searches and an alumni placement service are other services offered. The curriculum also embraces business and management competencies to prepare students for the ever-changing information management field and leadership positions. Election to membership is available to both undergraduate and graduate students in business. Career Advisors can help students post their resume and search for jobs using UWM's jobs board on Handshake. Grade Point Average Students are required to earn at least a 2.25 overall GPA to graduate. The Career Services Center also provides a resume referral service. General Electives Degree Completion Requirements Credits A minimum of 120 credits is required for graduation for all majors. Others focus on software programming, testing or support. While covering numerous material, students also tend to become excellent readers and researchers, extending benefits well beyond the classroom. BBA degree and major requirements must be completed within 10 years of initial enrollment at UW-Milwaukee. Most programs provide students with a strong background in programming, networking and engineering concepts. In addition, there is an emphasis on the communication skills and teamwork critical to client understanding and satisfaction. Internship positions and job requests are posted on a special bulletin board, which is maintained by the School as a service to students and to businesses that have specifically requested UWM business students to fill positions. Thanks to cutting edge technologies, learners are able to take advantage of quality instruction almost anywhere. Those interested in emerging fields may find opportunities in augmented reality and the internet of things. To that end, students are provided with a strong technical foundation in contemporary approaches to business application systems development which includes planning, analysis, design, project management, programming, maintenance, and support using state-of-the-art technologies, tools, and techniques, as well as an essential background in various business functional areas, such as management, marketing, accounting, finance, supply chain, and economics. While some students are able to cover their own expenses, others receive help from family or financial aid programs. Most universities give students numerous options for specializing in their particular areas of talent or interest. The cost of a bachelor's degree varies with each academic year and institution. Graduates of this program will be prepared to take the exams for CompTIA Cloud+, Mobility+, IT Project+, CSA (Cybersecurity Analyst) and Microsoft MCDBA (Microsoft Certified Database Administrator), leading to certifications. Beta Gamma Sigma is the national scholastic honor society in the field of business. Accounting majors must have earned a 2.5 GPA for all business and economics courses completed (including transfer credits), as well as a 2.5 GPA in all business and economics courses completed at UWM, to graduate. Commencement Honors Students with a cumulative GPA of 3.500 or above, based on a minimum of 40 graded UWM credits earned prior to the final semester, will receive all-university commencement honors and be awarded the traditional gold cord at the December or May Honors Convocation. Bachelor's degrees are offered at institutions of higher education in various parts of the world. No more than 50% of each certificate's credits may double count towards BBA Core or Major requirements. Each semester, students are invited to join Beta Gamma Sigma. See also information on the Business Scholars Program. Some choose to focus on business skills such as project management and vendor selection. Most students find that the rigor of a university program in technology management disciplines them to handle the demands they'll later be tasked with. At least 50% of the business credit hours required for the business degree must be completed at UWM. Such programs usually include a combination of general education, core and elective courses to create a personalized educational experience for each student. Students often use business electives to complete a double major or certificate. The ITM program is intended to be the first step in a lifelong learning experience in the exciting and dynamic field of ITM. The General Business Major may not be completed as a post-baccalaureate major/Certificate of Major. Some institutions cater to working professionals, offering courses in the evenings and on weekends. Dean's Honor List Students who earn a GPA of 3.500 or above on 12 or more graded credits in a given semester are placed on the Dean's Honor List. For information on Academic Advising for undergraduate business majors, see Undergraduate Student Services. All students should meet with an academic advisor at least once a semester. Depending on the program, students may be able to practice their skills using Microsoft, Cisco, Oracle and open-source technologies. Please note that for honors calculation, the GPA is not rounded and is truncated at the third decimal (e.g., 3.499). Juniors and seniors who build experience through internships may end up with job offers at the very organizations they started with. Post-Baccalaureate Options The above requirements refer to the full requirements of an initial bachelors degree only. As organizations continue streamlining operations and consumers constantly update their devices and demand new applications, work prospects should remain strong. Students must earn their last 30 credits at UWM. This program is offered as part of an accelerated bachelor's/master's program. It provides a strong foundation for advancement and success in ITM careers and ventures. Selection is based upon outstanding scholastic achievement. Residence Requirements A minimum of 12 credits must be completed in residence at UWM in each Business Administration major. Requirements of a second undergraduate degree are listed on the Lubar School's Policies and Regulations. The Accounting major may not be completed as a second undergraduate degree or as a post-baccalaureate major/Certificate of Major. The curriculum for this program also embraces business and management competencies to prepare students for the ever-changing information management field and leadership positions. A new 10-year time frame would then begin. This occurs in tandem with developing students' skills in advanced computing technology, such as Cloud computing, mobile applications development, web development and digital marketing, information technology risk and project management, database development and administration, data analytics, and cyber-security. Others provide programs that can be completed according to the student's own schedule. The course cannot be one a student has already taken as part of the foundation, core, or major coursework. Most programs provide students with a strong background in programming, networkin... Read more Bachelor's degrees are offered at institutions of higher education in various parts of the world. Potential employers may request resumes by functional area or by special interests within functional areas. Should students not complete the degree and major within the 10-year time frame, the students will switch to the most current degree and major requirements.
